

RESOLUTION 16011

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ALLOCATION OF THE VILLAGE OF SUAMICO'S STADIUM DISTRICT DOLLARS FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PURPOSES

The Board of Trustees of the Village Board of Suamico do resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, the Village of Suamico has received excess sales tax funds from the Lambeau Field Stadium sales tax in the amount of approximately \$604,479; and

WHEREAS, these dollars are to be used to stimulate economic development, pay off debt services or provide property tax relief; and

WHEREAS, both the Howard-Suamico Historical Society and the NEW Zoo serve as significant attractions to those visiting the Village of Suamico and providing a positive economic impact to businesses and commercial entities in the Village of Suamico; and

WHEREAS, this continued positive economic development is a benefit to the economic vitality of the entire community; and

WHEREAS, the request from the Howard-Suamico Historical Society for \$15,5000 for building renovations (new roof) to the Ancestry Acres property will rehabilitate a structure that will be used for social and educational purposes that will attract additional persons to the Village of Suamico and Brown County area; and


WHEREAS, the request from the NEW Zoo for \$5,000 of new equipment will further enhance the Zoo and its operations that are frequented by many visitors on a regular and annual basis.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of Suamico Village Board authorizes the release and contributions of monies as such:


- Howard-Suamico Historical Society - \$15,500
