

RESOLUTION 16013

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2017 GENERAL FUND, SPECIAL REVENUE FUNDS, DEBT SERVICE FUND, CAPITAL PROJECTS FUNDS, TID FUNDS, ENGINEERING FUND, GARBAGE/RECYCLING FUND, STORMWATER FUND AND ACCOMPANYING LEVIES AND INCORPORATING THE 2018-2021 PROPOSED BUDGETS AS A GUIDE FOR FUTURE PLANNING PURPOSES SUBJECT TO CHANGE BY FUTURE BOARDS

The Board of Trustees of the Village Board of Suamico does resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, the Village Board of trustees has reviewed the general operating, capital, TID #1, TID #2, TID#4, debt service, engineering, garbage/recycling, storm water, and special revenue budgets for fiscal year 2017, and

WHEREAS, the budgets were posted for inspection, according to Wisconsin Statutes §65.90 on November 4, 2016 and


WHEREAS, the appropriate public hearing was held on November 21, 2016 at 7:00 PM at the Suamico Municipal Service Center, 12781 Velp Avenue, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the 2017 general operating, capital, TID #1, TID #2, TID #4, debt service, engineering, garbage/recycling, storm water, and special revenue fund budgets (as presented) be adopted in their summary form as attached to this resolution and the accompanying 2017 – 2020 general operating, capital, TID #1, TID #2, TID #4, debt service, engineering, garbage/recycling, storm water, and special revenue fund budgets be incorporated with the adopted 2017 budget as a guide for future planning purposes only; subject to change by future boards.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village Board has determined the 2016 apportioned tax levy for the 2017 budget to be \$ 4,670,653 ; a garbage/recycling rate of \$170 per household (REU) for 2016; a 2016 storm water REU fee of \$25 per year; and charge out rates for the Engineering Fund be set at \$90 per hour for engineering technician services and \$120 for senior engineer services.
