Stained Glass Class For Beginners: 6 weeks, 3 hours per week.

Learn how to design, or use an existing pattern to create your own stained glass project.

Projects may include, but are not limited to, sun catchers, window panels, jewelry boxes, picture frames, and other decorative items.

In the Beginning Stained Glass Class, the instructor will provide the basic tools, equipment and pattern books, in limited quantity, which students may use to learn and practice basic skills. As the student progresses in their level of skills, it is recommended that they purchase their own equipment.

Below is a list of tools needed for beginner projects, prior to the first class (The following basic tools will cost approximately \$35.00 - \$65.00):

- Glass cutter
- Breaking pliers
- Permanent markers (example: Sharpies)
- Ruler
- Safety glasses

Depending on the project, additional supplies will be needed:

- Glass will range from \$8.00 \$20.00 per square foot (most beginning projects involve 3 4 square feet of glass, with pieces left over for future projects).
- Additional supplies needed: flux, solder and foil, which will cost approximately \$30.00

Depending on the project, most students will spend approximately \$100.00 for this class.

If students continue with glass crafting, after the 6-week or 9-week class, they will need to purchase their own equipment, which may cost between \$225.00 and \$300.00.

The instructors will discuss resources and cost-saving options for the following equipment:

- Grinder
- Foiler
- Came Saw
- Cutting board

Supplies and equipment may be obtained from the following resources:

- Companies such as Delphi and Glass Crafters by catalog or online.
- Local retailers such as Hobby Lobby and The Glass House.

There are also many additional on-line sources that the students may locate by searching for "stained glass".
