



CLEANING YOUR FAUCET AERATORS



Cleaning your faucet aerators:

Periodically cleaning your faucet aerators is a smart move. The faucet aerators are the devices that regulate the flow of water. During the course of time, natural deposits can become trapped inside these devices. Removing the aerators periodically and cleaning them takes only a few minutes.

1. Unscrew the small round piece that is attached to the underside of the faucet. It may need a wrench to unscrew the aerator, give it a gentle counter-clockwise turn.
2. In most cases, just flushing out the debris will remove all the debris. If there is still grime and small particles, just brush with an old toothbrush and vinegar.
3. Soak in vinegar as long as necessary, then brush clean and rinse with water.
4. Reassemble the aerator to the faucet.
5. Repeat whenever you feel it is necessary to prevent build-up.
