



Greater Green Bay Back to Business Grant

COVID-19 has altered life - including business operations - as we know it. The ways the Greater Green Bay Chamber is delivering on its mission and vision have changed but our purpose has not. **#GreenBayMade: We still mean business.**

Small- and medium-size companies' operations have been significantly impacted as a result of COVID-19. We know 40% of small businesses have, or are seeking, financial support. With this in mind, we have created a short-term **Greater Green Bay Back to Business Grant** fund.

The funds will be awarded to Brown County businesses with fewer than (50) FTE employees, with a priority to those that have frequent and close contact with customers. Non-profit organizations and businesses that have received the PPP or EIDL are not eligible. Grants will be awarded in amounts up to \$10,000.

Eligible business: An eligible business is a business in an industry outlined in Emergency Order #12 – Safer at Home Order, or any subsequent Emergency Order, or demonstrates it is otherwise affected by the COVID-19 outbreak due to a decrease in physical foot traffic on which their business depends.

The following requirements must be met:

- Physical business presence in Brown County;
- Employ 2-50 employees;
- In business for 2+ years;
- Demonstrated income loss as a result of the Emergency Order #12 or COVID-19 outbreak;
- *Note: Greater Green Bay Chamber membership not required.*

Ineligible uses: Grants are not available for property management/landlord for either commercial and/or residential customers, nor any speculative venture, investment venture, research and development or home- based occupations.

Submission of an application does not guarantee funding. All applications will be reviewed by a 4-person independent committee.
