Village of Suamico Announces Polling Location Change for November General Election

SUAMICO, Wisconsin— In response to staffing and social distancing challenges resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, it has become necessary for the Village to make changes to the polling locations for the November 3, 2020 General Election. **All** voters choosing to vote on election day will vote at 2310 Lineville Road, Suamico, WI 54313 in the building vacated by The Marq. The building is directly to the east of the Shopko building in the Urban Edge Towne Centre. We want to thank Jeff Noeldner with Midwest Expansion for graciously allowing the Village to utilize the facility at no cost to the Village. Postcards will be mailed to all residents in October alerting them to the change in venue.

Our election workers will be available to assist voters while ensuring the facility is as clean and safe as possible. Extra efforts will be taken to wipe down voting booths and election equipment throughout the day. If you have had a fever, respiratory symptoms, or believe you are sick, please consider requesting a ballot to be mailed to you. Curbside voting will also be available should you not feel comfortable entering the building.

Absentee ballots will be mailed beginning Thursday, September 17, 2020. You may request an absentee ballot online at myvote.wi.gov prior to October 29 at 5:00pm, and a ballot will be mailed to you. If you do not have internet access, you may request an absentee ballot in writing to the Village Clerk, 12781 Velp Avenue, Suamico, WI 54313 or via email at melissah@suamico.org. You must include a copy of your photo ID, address, date of birth, phone number, and election date with your request or we will not be able to process your request. Please be sure to allow sufficient mailing time as we must receive your ballot back on or before Election Day. Given the current situation with COVID-19, we strongly encourage you to utilize this method of voting. Voting absentee by mail is especially important for the elderly, those who have traveled recently, and those who have a suppressed immune system.

Voters are also able to vote “In-Person Absentee” at the Municipal Services Center, 12781 Velp Avenue, beginning Tuesday, October 20 until Friday October 30, 2020 - Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. (October 29th and 30th until 5:00 p.m.). If you choose to vote in-person, we ask voters to stand a proper distance from each other to help protect our elderly and high-risk populations from the potential spread of COVID-19.
